among the social sororities with an average of 2.882 grade points: Sigma Delta Tau, fifth, 2.852; Alpha Delta Theta, sixth, 2.808; Kappa Alpha Theta, seventh, 2.806; Delta Delta Delta, eighth, 2.776; Delta Delta Sigma, ninth, 2.768; Alpha Omicron Pi, sixteenth, 2.627; Alpha Phi, seventeenth, 2.620; Gamma Phi Beta, eighteenth, 2.578; Theta Phi Alpha, nineteenth, 2.566; Pi Beta Phi, twentieth, 2.4707; and Alpha Delta Pi, twenty-first, 2.335.

Phi Mu, Alpha, ranked fourth among the professional fraternities with an average of 2.702; Delta Sigma Phi, fifth, 2.695; Delta Theta Phi, sixth, 2.665; Sigma Gamma Epsilon, seventh, 2.634; Delta Sigma Delta, eighth, 2.537; Alpha Chi Sigma, ninth, 2.511; Alpha Gamma Rho, tenth, 2.4702; Psi Phi, eleventh, 2.288; Phi Delta Phi, twelfth, 2.285.

Phi Chi Theta was fourth among the professional sororities with an average of 2.822 and Sigma Alpha Beta was fifth with an average of 2.667 grade points. The Delian Union had an average of 2.290 grade points. Averaging 3.346 grade points, Howard Hall, a girls' cooperative house, had the highest scholastic rating of any undergraduate group for the second semester of 1932-33, according to an announcement released by the dean of student affairs. Mu Phi Epsilon, a professional sorority, ranked second with an average of 2.503 grade points. Phi Epsilon Omicron, also a professional sorority, won third place with an average of 2.145 grade points.

The Grading System. In determining the average grade points by which the groups were ranked, four grade points were awarded for each credit hour

carried with a grade of 90 and above, three grade points were awarded for each credit hour earned with a grade of 80 to 89. Two grade points were awarded for each hour carried with a grade of 70 to 79, and one grade point is awarded for each credit hour carried with a grade of 60 to 69. No grade points are awarded for credit hours incomplete, and one grade point is subtracted for each credit hour failed or dropped in bad standing. To obtain the average for each group, the total grade points are divided by the total number of hours carried by the group.

This a rating of 4 would show that all grades averaged 90 or above, a rating of 3 would show that all grades averaged 80 to 89; a rating of 2 would show that all grades averaged 70 to 79, and a rating of 1 would show that all grades averaged 60 to 69.

Sigma Alpha Mu, a social fraternity, had the highest average of any group of men with an average of 2.811 grade points. Alpha Kappa Psi and Farm House, professional fraternities, ranked second and third places with averages of 2.788 and 2.764 grade points respectively.

The all-student average for the semester was 2.981. The all-women average was 2.631 while

among the professional sororities with an average of 3.346. Phi Upsilon Omicron, was second with an average of 3.145 and Theta Sigma Phi, third with an average of 2.925 grade points.

the all-men average was 2.2219 grade points. Topping the non-sorority average of 2.581, the members of sororities averaged 2.706. The non-fraternity men, however, averaged 2.228 as compared with the all-fraternity average of 2.208.

Women students averaged 2.631 grade points while men students averaged 2.219. Phi Omega Pi ranked highest among the social sororities with an average of 2.934 while the Sigma Alpha Mu had the highest average of any social fraternity. Kappa Delta, a social sorority, ranked second in the social sorority ratings with an average of 2.940 grade points and Alpha Chi Omega, third with a 2.919 average.

Alpha Kappa Psi headed the professional fraternities with an average of 2.788. Farm House ranked second with 2.764 and Sigma Delta Chi, third with 2.738. Mu Phi Epsilon ranked highest

among the professional sororities with an average of 3.346. Phi Upsilon Omicron, was second with an average of 3.145 and Theta Sigma Phi, third with an average of 2.925 grade points.

Phi Omega Pi ranked highest among the social sororities with an average of 2.934 while the Sigma Alpha Mu had the highest average of any social fraternity. Kappa Delta, a social sorority, ranked second in the social sorority ratings with an average of 2.940 grade points and Alpha Chi Omega, third with a 2.919 average.

Alpha Kappa Psi headed the professional fraternities with an average of 2.788. Farm House ranked second with 2.764 and Sigma Delta Chi, third with 2.738. Mu Phi Epsilon ranked highest
