Biff puts gridders through long drill for Baylor game

Baylor to bring team of veterans

Fourteen lettermen are numbered on the Baylor Bear squad which will play here Saturday, and while most of the men in the starting lineup are veterans, the Bruins sophomores were the best freshmen the Waco school ever had.

Last year the Baylor team was led by Billy Patterson, whom Biff Jones called one of the country's greatest players. Patterson was a bulls-eye passer, and the Bruins played a wide-open game last fall.

However, this year, behind the rushes of 200 pound Jackie Wilson, sophomore sensation, and letterman Jimmy Witt, the Bears switched to a power game which beat Arizona, Witt and Wilson scored against the Razorbacks.

It is the Baylor line, tho, which is expected to carry the Bruins

far this season. The forward wall averages well over 200, and Coach Morley Jennings has veterans from end to end, and only one touchdown has been scored in three games on Baylor, which is undefeated as yet.

Starting ends against Arkansas were Sherman Barnes, 197, and W. J. Wimpee, 195, both two-year lettermen, Jack Lummus, Barnes

sub, recovered an Arkansas fumble for a touchdown Saturday, while another squadman, Wilson Lucas, fills in for Wimpee.

Bennett Edwards whose weight is listed at 210 and Frank Marx, a 215 pounder, both lettermen, hold down the tackle positions.

The Bears, like Nebraska, are strong at guards. Leonard Akin, 210 pounder and Bobby Taylor, 190, who both received all-Southwest mention last year, are the regulars.

The Bears, although they haven't opened up much in a passing way, will bring an aerial attack headed by Jim Witt, 175 pound junior halfback in the starting lineup, and little sophomore Dwight Parks.

Big Jack Wilson, 202 pound sophomore, is also a passing threat.

Thirty-two Baylor players left Waco yesterday for Lincoln while Jones was attempting to correct the "bookful" of mistakes made by the Huskers against Iowa State last week.

The game is rated a toss-up, but Jones fired up the Huskers to beat Minnesota after an unimpressive opener against Minnesota. If it happens again, the Huskers will be on their game after a letdown last week, and we think Nebraska will come through in a real ball game.
