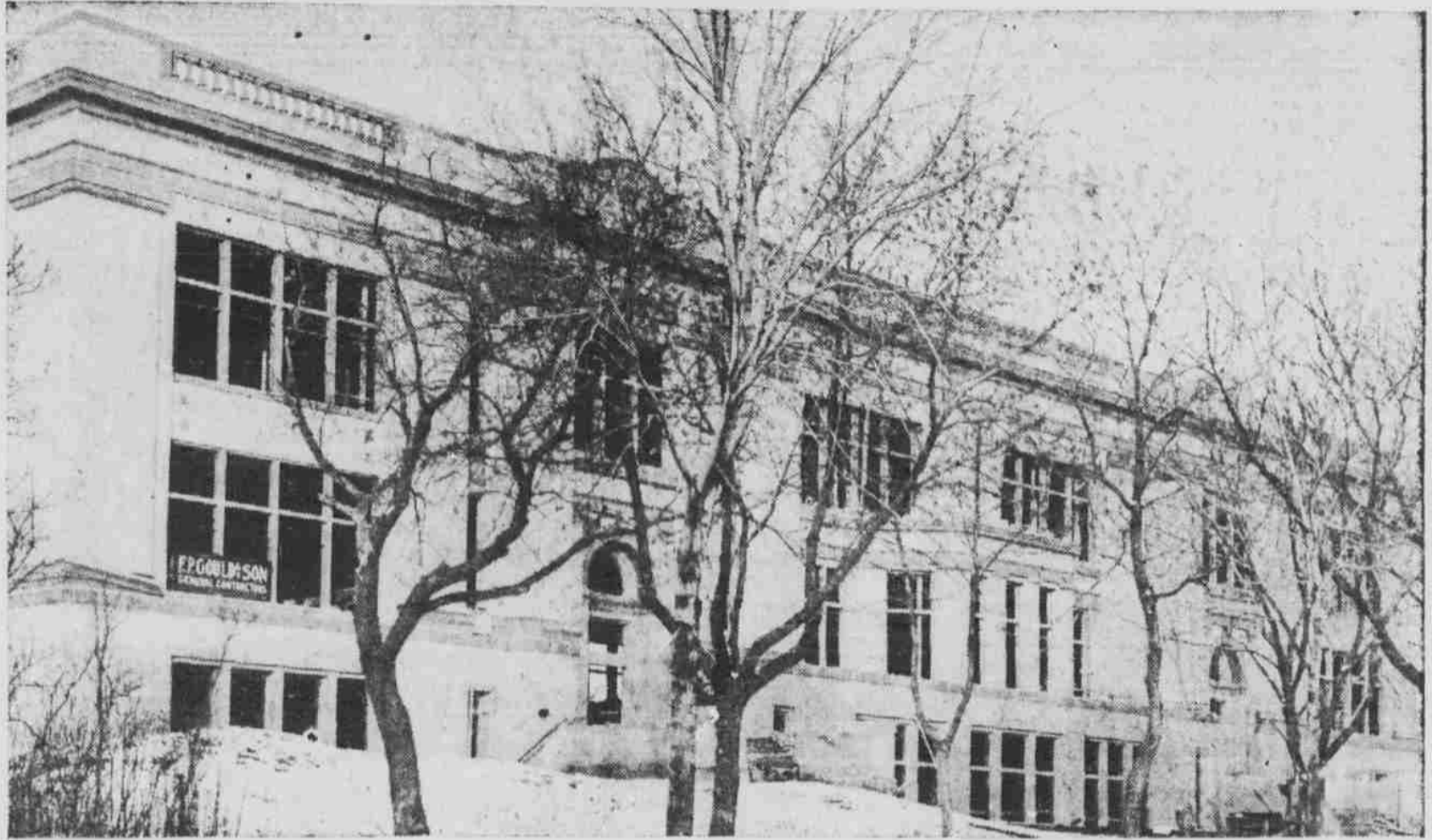

New Engineering Hall Opens in 1942

The engineering mechanics hall, formerly Bancroft school, will be ready for full occupancy by the fall of 1942, according to the engineering department.

This fall only a small part of the engineering mechanics department will be moved into the new building and the transition will

not be completed for approximately a year.

In order to furnish the university teachers college with observation classes for student teachers, three-fourths of the first and second floors will continue as city grade school.

When the proposed remodeling

plans are completed, the former grade school will include a laboratory wing, drawing, class and seminar rooms, offices, space for student assistants and blueprinting equipment, testing laboratories and the general office of the highway testing department. Laboratory wing will contain a shop, a

tool room, a highway testing laboratory, a fuel, lubricant and bitumens laboratory, and materials testing machine.

Prof. W. L. DeBaufre, chairman of the engineering mechanics department, Prof. P. K. Slaymaker and R. E. Edgecomb who designed the laboratory wing have moved into their new offices.
