engineer's open house the locomotive was on exhibition, and in place of steam it was operated on compress air. To be completed the tank must be finished and the cab must be put on. Also outside fixtures will be placed on the engine to dress it up.

Hoping that the locomotive will be completed this year, Barnard is looking forward to the construction of a test stand for the engine. The stand will serve the double purpose of testing and as an exhibition. The test stand will work on the principle of a treadmill. The wheels of the locomotive will rest on the wheels of the test stand. When in operation the wheels will form friction and as a

result a pull will be produced on the locomotive. The test stand, however, will take another three or four years to complete.
