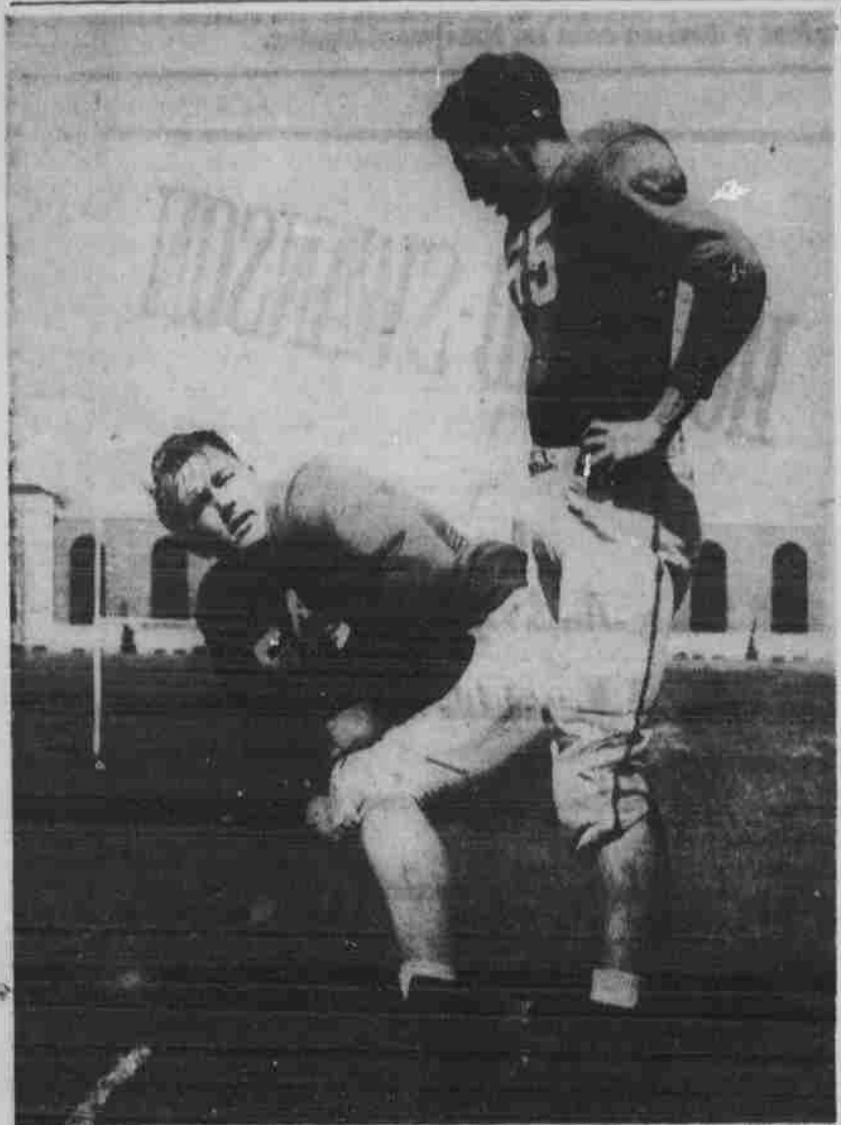


Husker Squad Turns Out
