The Kenton Crew proves a real disappointment on this disc, for this, I would list as one of his poorest releases. June Christy sounds sharp on "Alamo," and the solo listed for Vido Musso materializes as merely a few riff bars on the tenor sax. The Pastels show very definitely on "Love" that they still lack that punch needed to make them a great vocal group. (Cap. 387)

** Fine and Dandy
** Lonesome Road

These two numbers are handled by the Goodman Quintet and Quartet respectively. Only redeeming feature of either side is some fine accoridian jazz played by Ernie Filice, west coast cat. The remainder of "Dandy" is nowhere. Without Filice, "Road" has nothing to speak of. (Cap. 394)

The Dorsey crew rides rampant over "Bingo," and it's one of Billy Finnegan's fine scorings. There is some fine trumpet that sounds like Charlie Shavers, and the whole band comes in for a good share of expression on this tune. It's one of Dorsey's finer jump numbers. On "Spring" Stuart Foster handles the vocal in his usual pleasing manner, but I am unable to find anything too outstanding about the side. (Victor 20-2196)

VETS NEWS

Veterans under Public Law 346 (the G. I. Bill) who are not planning to attend summer school, may now make application for leave of absence subsistence by reporting to the office of the Veterans Consultation Board, 101 Mechanic Arts Hall.

Leave accumulates at the rate of 2½ days per month of school attendance up to a maximum of 30 days. Applications for Leave of Absence subsistence for those not attending summer school must be made on or before May 26.

Veterans attending summer school cannot apply for vacation subsistence until the end of the summer session, at which time announcements concerning the same will be made.

TWA Offers Pilot Training

Applications for student co-pilots to be trained by the TWA flight training section in Kansas City, Mo., may be made at the nearest TWA personnel office.

Qualifications include: Flight Time; 1,200 hours first pilot; commercial certificate of competency; CAA instrument rating; radio telephone permit, third class; age 22 to 26 years, inclusive; height 5'6" to 6' 2", inclusive; pass TWA physical examination; two years college or equivalent.

Salary Scale.

Minimum salary is \$220 a month with co-pilots receiving an increase of \$20 per month each six months. Captains receive a base pay, an hourly pay and mile-

age pay. Both co-pilots and captains receive a per diem allowance while away from their home base.
