Until 1942, only two women had represented the university in an interstate debate. In the fall of 1941, under the leadership of Dr. Leroy T. Laase women were asked to participate in debate for the first time in forty years.

The question of admitting women to the debate squad has been a subject of much controversy. When the Debating Association was being reorganized in the fall of 1901, the word "male" was struck from the membership


