Husker Nine Captures Third Road Victory

Nebraska university's baseball team won its third game of the season and its first loop game Friday when the Huskers romped over Oklahoma's nine, 16-4.

The Huskers cracked 16 hits while the Sooners were collecting only three safeties. Big Jim Sandstedt worked until the ninth inning. Angelo Ossino took over and hurled hitless ball in his one inning.

Both teams were unsteady in the high wind. Oklahoma made nine errors, and Nebraska made six. The Huskers scored in every inning except the seventh and eighth. Only four of the 13 runs made off Sooner Pitcher Elton Davis were earned.

Wes Maser, Nebraska right-fielder, knocked in five runs before leaving the game with a sprained ankle. Leftfielder Fritz Hegwood collected four safeties. The Huskers stole nine bases.

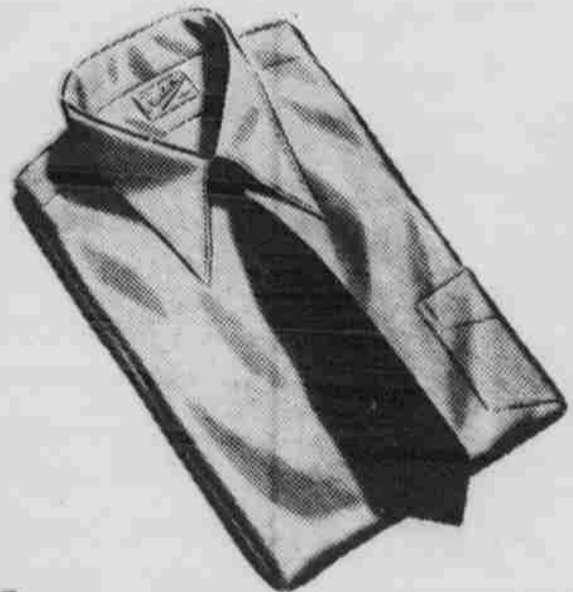
