

# University Sets Fiscal Budget At \$6,673,048

A University operating budget of \$6,673,048 for the 1949-'50 fiscal year was approved by the Board of Regents this summer.

The budget represents a four and one-half per cent increase over expenditures totaling \$6,387,718 for the past fiscal year.

Revenue for the present fiscal year comes from four sources: the state general fund (property tax), \$4,000,000; federal funds, \$789,137; student fees, endowment incomes and state vocational funds, \$1,841,200; and \$250,000 from the University's share of the special state institutions building and maintenance levy.

C. Y. Thompson, president of the Board of Regents, said the budget represents an overall 12 per cent reduction in funds requested by the deans and directors of the University's various colleges and divisions.

The difference in funds available to the University and the school's needs are being met by several actions. These steps enabled the University to give small increases in funds to several agencies, including the Ag college, the Agricultural Experiment Station, the College of Medicine and the University hospital.
