

# Livestock judges 'promising'

UNL's livestock judging team finished 10th in a 30-team field at the National Western Stock Show in Denver last weekend.

Jud Baldrige tried for second out of 150 contestants in the swine judging competition to lead Nebraska in individual placing.

The team, coached by animal science professor R.B. Warren, competed in the carlot and individual stock judging categories.

Warren who is coaching his 31st team said the team judged 63 practice classes at various locations to prepare for the Denver competition.

The Denver show was the first competition of this semester. Warren said

he expects the team to improve in the future.

"We went out there to win," he said. "We don't bust our butts to finish tenth."

Team members are Kent Anderson of Lexington, Baldrige of North Platte, Susan Borgelt of Wisner, Jeff Gibbens of Comstock and Pat Yeutter of Eustis.

Carlot competitors were Terry Acton of Holmesville, Kevin Pentz of Lexington, Mark Nisley of Bennet, Jeff Rudolph of Dunbar and Duane Starkey of Denton.

"This group shows a lot of promise," Warren said. "The competitiveness of this group is very keen."

Baldrige, a junior majoring in agricultural economics, said being on the team has helped him in his public speaking skills and has made him think more in-depth about livestock.

The team's only goal is "to do the best we can," he said.

The next competition for the team is Jan. 28 in Sioux Falls, S.D.

# Pro life march slated Saturday

Pro-life supporters will protest the anniversary of legal abortion Saturday with the 11th annual Walk for Life in downtown Lincoln.

Ellen Snoddy, vice president of Lincoln Right to Life, said the walk commemorates the U.S. Supreme Court decision to legalize abortion on Jan. 22, 1973.

"It's a day of public outcry to call attention to the problem of abortion," Snoddy said. "It reminds us of the 15 million babies that have been killed by abortion since 1973."

The silent walk from 15th and P streets to the Capitol will begin at 10 a.m. Omaha Mayor Mike Boyle, state Senators Bernice Labeledz of Omaha and Loran Schmidt of Bellwood will give speeches at the Capitol. Snoddy said 2,000 people participated in the march last year, and, depending on the weather, more are expected this year.
