K-State ready to drop loser image

Four winning seasons in the past 45 years is not much of a

winning tradition, but Kansas State football players and coaches still are optimistic that 1984 will be the year to begin a new winning tradition.

Two years ago, optimism was high for Kansas State coach Jim Dickey and his Wildcats. After gambling and redshirting almost all of his juniors in 1981, the Cats posted their first winning season in more than 10 years and made their first post-season bowl appearance in the Liberty Bowl.

But, they returned to business as usual in 1983, posting a 3-8 record.

"We lacked confidence last year," Dickey said. "I was embarrassed and our players were embarrassed with the season."

Despite the poor showing, Dickey said he is still optimistic about this year's team.

"Our talent is very similar to what we had two years ago," Dickey said.

Kansas State returns most of its 1983 squad, with nine returning starters on offense and eight starters on defense, along with punter Scott Fulhage and place-kicker Steve Willis. Leading the list of returning starters is fifth-year senior quarterback Stan Weber.

Weber got his first starting assignment last year against the Huskers and led the Wildcats to a surprising 20-point outburst to draw

Kansas State within 13 points in the fourth quarter. Nebraska rallied, however, and won 52-25.

Nonetheless, it was a good showing for Weber, who led his team to victory the next week in a 21-30 upset over Oklahoma State.

Weber is an option quarterback with a reputation as a good passer. He gives the Wildcat offense the confidence it needs, Dickey said.

"Stan is a competitor and gives us great leadership," Dickey said. "He believes in himself."

On defense, Kansas State will be led by lineman Les Miller and linebacker Bob Daniels.

Daniels is considered the hardest worker on the Kansas State squad and was second on the

team in tackles behind all-Big Eight performer Reggie Singletary, one of the few graduation losses.

Miller came on strong at the end of last season and won AP Defensive Newcomer of the Year honors in the Big Eight. At 6-6, 280 pounds, Miller again is expected to be a stopper in the Kansas State defense.

New to the Kansas State defense will be linebacker coach Tim McGuire. McGuire was a member of Nebraska's 1975 squad and went on to coach the defensive line at UNO from 1978 to 1980. He also coached at Morningside College for two seasons. McGuire is also the brother of Nebraska baseball player Bill McGuire.

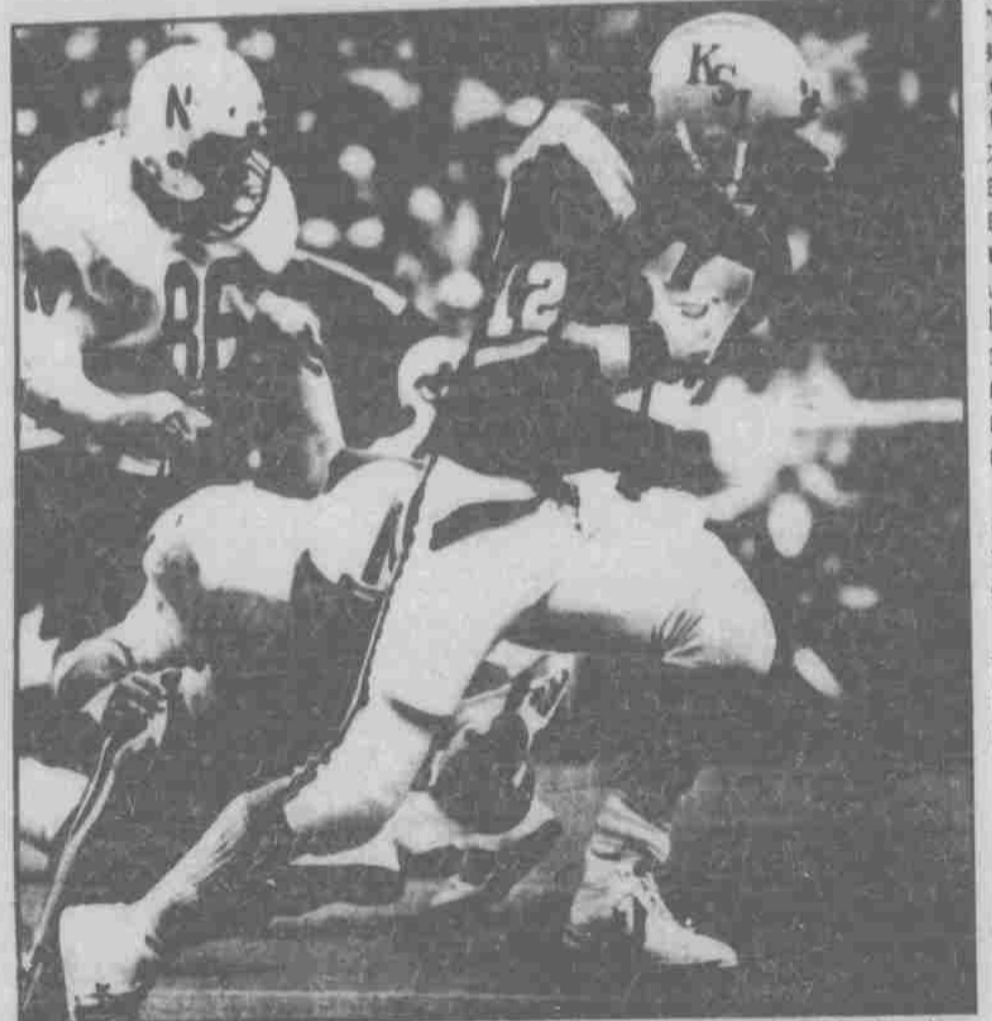
