McCartney will have his starting quarterback from 1983 back. Steve Vogel passed for 1,385 yards a year ago. McCartney said his wide receivers will be tough this year as well. He also hopes the play of Lee Rouson at tailback will be strong.

"I think Rouson will be the player to watch on our team and he has the best chance for post-season honors," McCartney said.

Even though, there are only three starters back on defense, McCartney said he thinks defense will be the strength of this year's team.

"We've been real happy with our defense in practice, especially our inside linebackers," he said.

Last year's record was an unimpressive 4-7 and McCartney is hoping for improvement this year. But real success may be a few seasons away, as Colorado had its biggest recruiting season this year since McCartney's arrival.

McCartney said several things contributed to the successful recruiting.

"We've started a summer football camp which gives high school players a chance to meet the coaches and get a taste of our program. We've also been encouraging more walk-ons, and generally been trying to get more people interested in Colorado football," he said.

Whatever McCartney did, it must have worked. Some wire services ranked Colorado's recruiting class among the best in the nation. According to McCartney, this will help to strengthen the program in the future, but it won't help much this season.

"We'll just have to work hard and hope for the best," he said. "But I think we will surprise some people this year."

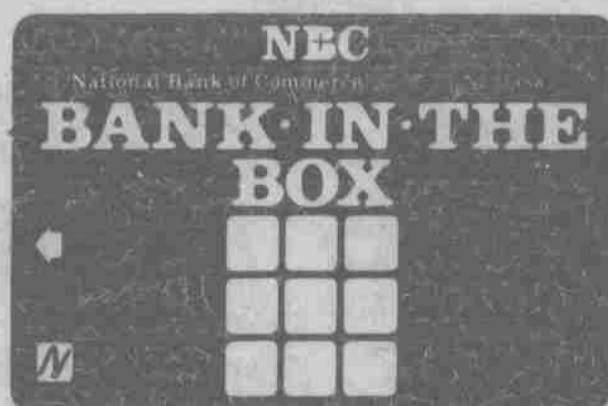
