

# Husker runners trek to Illinois

The men's and women's cross country teams travel to the Illini Invitational at the University of Illinois after a successful meet last weekend at the Jayhawk Invitational.

The Husker men finished second behind Kansas State, but coach Jay Dirksen said that if Gerard O'Callaghan had not dropped out of the race because of a sore Achilles' tendon, the meet would have been very close. O'Callaghan was in the top five when he dropped out.

The women finished second to Kansas State. Dirksen said he thinks Kansas State could challenge Iowa State for the Big Eight title. Dirksen said that if Jill Noel would have run a better race, the

meet might have been more interesting.

"We had a great meet last week but the Illini Invitational will be a lot tougher," Dirksen said.

Dirksen said the Huskers will have their hands full because many teams in Region IV want to run the course because it is where the region meet is later on this year.

"This will be a good indicator on where we stand compared to good teams, but we will be competitive," Dirksen said.

Competing at the meet will be 10 men's teams and 13 women's teams. Dirksen said that in the men's race, the top teams to beat will be Illinois, Purdue and Indiana State. The women's team will

have their hands full with Northwestern, Ohio State, Indiana and Indiana State.

"The course is flat and fast and that is really good because the last two meets have been on really tough courses," Dirksen said.

Last year the men's team finished second to Illinois. But Dirksen said he thinks the competition will be tougher this year. The women's team last year finished ninth. Dirksen said he will take only six women because Sue Nelson has a sprained ankle.

Dirksen said only seven men will travel to the meet, and that O'Callaghan will run.

Next weekend the Cornhuskers will travel to the Colorado Invitational in Boulder, Colo.

## Crew rowing on ...

It's rowing season. The UNL Crew takes to the road tonight to compete against the University of Iowa, the University of Chicago, and the Chicago-based Lincoln Park Boat Club, at Iowa City, Ia.

The small-boat regatta will be run English Henley-style, that is, two boats in each heat. Nebraska is taking a 30-member squad to row in six events.

In competitive sweep rowing, each rower has one oar and slides back and forth on a wooden seat using the legs for a majority of the power through the stroke. The small-boat regatta is for two- and four-oared shells. Nebraska will compete in eight oared events at other regattas this fall.

The regatta will run Saturday from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m., allowing Iowa rowers and fans to get back to the football stadium for homecoming.
