

# Kansas town to host three-dimensional art show

On April 26 through 28, the city of Lenexa, Kan., will hold its first annual national three-dimensional art show in Lenexa's Sar-Ko-Par park, Mayor Rich Becker announced.

The juried art show is expected to attract many of the finest artists from throughout the Uni-

ted States in media such as metals, glass, ceramics, fiber, jewelry, sculpture and wood, among others.

The goal of the show is to bring together in Lenexa the best efforts of artists, with no constraint on style or content in any three-dimensional form.

In addition to the purchase award commitments from businesses and individuals, cash awards in excess of \$4,500 will be made.

Sponsored by the city of Lenexa, the show is funded by revenue set aside to promote conventions and tourism.

Sar-Ko-Par, the site of the show, is a 12-acre park with an adjoining lake.

Large sculptures will be situated in a sculpture park configuration. The sculptures will remain in place for several weeks after the closing of the show for continued public viewing.

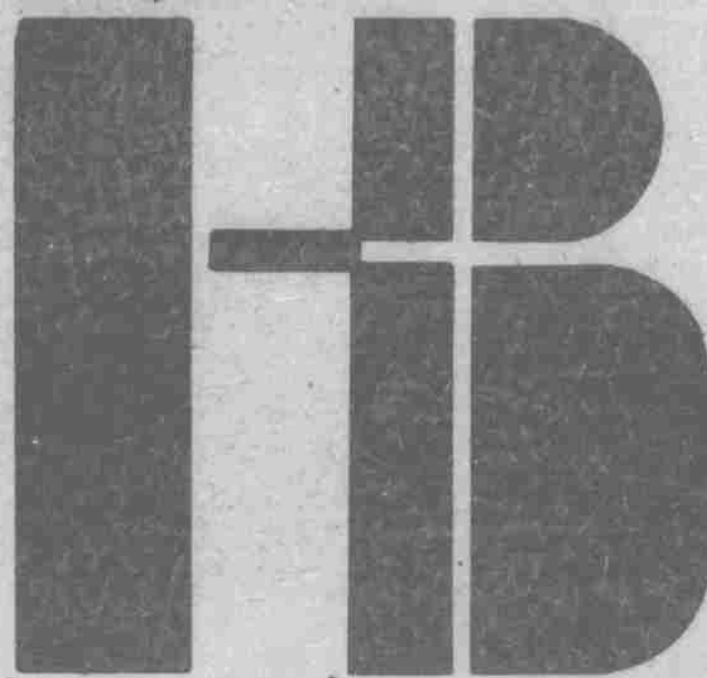
