There can be but one result of this refusal to do so. The Milwaukee and St. Paul will withdraw from the pool and a most disastrous freight war will follow.

Best Grapes for a Small Place.

A village lot affords little room for doubtful experiments; therefore it is desirable for such homes to have well-tried varieties, likely to succeed with moderate care, unless, indeed, the owner is expert as a vine-dresser. Hence I would say, for my experience, for one vine plant Concord; for three vines, add Lady, white, and Brighton, red. For six vines, add to the above Early Victor, black, Vergennes, red, and Prentiss, white, or, in place of these last, take Worden, black, Catawba, red, and Pocklington, white.

Trimming Fruit Trees.

The trimming out of the over-dense tops of trees may be commenced at any time, and continue through the winter, as leisure is found. In thinning out it will be better to take out many small limbs by several cuts than to remove large ones by cutting once only. Large wounds do not heal as readily, and taking out large limbs leaves the tree less well balanced. The aim should be to diminish the number of fruit buds by thinning out the small twigs. Mr. Hilman, of Marlboro, who has great success with his trees, cuts back freely with light pruning shears, thus accomplishing his object without making any large wounds.
