Monsignor Capel, the distinguished divine and orator, lectured again last night, but this time at the catholic cathedral, his subject being, "Marriage and Divorce."

The attendance was only fair, not what it ought to have been, because in the subject chosen, Monsignor Capel is an eloquent and pleading speaker.

The marriage ceremony is of divine origin, the speaker quoted that passage of scripture which says, "It is not good for man to be alone," as an example by which to prove the assertion.

He held that the creator could have had He so chosen, created every man separately but He preferred to delegate that power unto man, therefore incentive should be a means of making doubly sacred the marriage tie.

The first idea of marriage is a union of two persons, and to effect that union it is necessary that there be mutual consent on the part of the contracting parties.

The speaker dwelt at considerable length on the propriety and adaptability of making life contracts and showed that too many unfortunate marriages are made on a basis of expediency, or personal beauty or wealth.

His remarks on divorce, and the law which permits a separation of husband and wife, were listened to with a great deal of attention and interest.
