We had never seen a better rider when we were together than when he was in the army. He rode a rather fractious horse that he guided and controlled with perfect science. He was an expert in the cavalry saber drill, and there was scarcely a better swordsman in the regiment. He used every point like a man when he stripped himself of his armor, and went to congress. He has made all the fame since then that any man could desire, but for all that who were his old companions can't help feeling that he had remained a soldier instead of going into congress. The congressman he would not be lying on his deathbed today."
