

THE SPECULATIVE MARKETS

It was almost forgotten on the Board of Trade yesterday.

CORN WAS QUITE WEAK AND LOWER

Heavy Exports Strengthened Wheat a Little—Traders Seemed Absorbed in Watching the Progress of Cholera—Stocks and Bonds.

Contract No. 5—It was almost stagnation on the Board of Trade. The general feeling seemed to be that while the cholera shadow is hanging over the market there can be little activity and no material improvement. When closed with about a gain. Corn with 4% up, wheat about the same. Wheat stocks strengthened a little by heavy exports, the falling off in the local receipts and the small proportion which graded contract, was extremely slow all through the session. The traders seemed to be absorbed watching the progress of the cholera. The bulletins from New York were closely studied. Outside trade seemed to have come to a standstill and combination houses complained of unusual difficulty in getting distribution to rail and value held very steady. The entire fluctuation for the day covered a range of only 16¢ with business of light volume. There was a report from the northwest that farmers were holding their wheat rather than sell at present prices.

Corn was weak and lower early, mainly on the absence of fresh lead. It was followed by a slight upturn, and would soon be out of danger. This led to free selling for long corn and short sellers, who were very active on the market, but had no market from our figures. Later shorts took advantage of the break to cover, and, as there was no market for sale, price quickly fell again. A rise in the morning of the same time helped the corn market and the early decline was recovered, but the general turned weak again.

Outs strengthened strongly with corn, following that general closely all day. There was a fair trade in provisions with some activity, but little change.

The most active market was oats, with 4% up.
