ALL ARE ANXIOUS TO BE POSTMASTER

Aspirants for the Position and Their Dilemma

An Appointment Demanded as Source for Defeat—Four of the Most Prominent Aspirants.

Ever since last Wednesday morning at 1 o'clock the democrats of Council Bluffs have been busy engaged in trying to name the successor to Postmaster M. T. Tilton. This office, with a salary of \$3,000 a year, and the prestige it gives the holder, is one very much sought after by the politicians, and there is likely to be some great war-polling between now and next fall, when Tilton's term expires. So far four applicants have been heard from, with a prospect of others turning up from time to time. Ex-Congressman Thomas Dawson is thought by many to have the inside track, from the fact that he has the position under consideration of the county committee and has the support of the friends of the present incumbent, and his friends claim that he should be favored with the appointment in compensation for his defeat. S. B. Wadsworth, chairman of the county committee, and Ira F. Hendricks, whose term of office as county auditor expires with the year, are also understood to be candidates for the place. All four of these gentlemen have been prominent in local politics, and while legitimate means are used to get the nomination, they are not far from being open to the charge of being unscrupulous.

NEW ORLEANS STRIKE ENDED

After a Long Struggle the Men Are Compelled to Give it Up.

BUSINESS AGAIN RESUMED IN THE CITY

After Two Weeks of Embarassment the City Settles Down to Its Normal Condition—Governor Foster's Determination Brings About the Result.

NEW ORLEANS, La., Nov. 11.—The great labor strike which commenced in this city October 22 ended this morning at 3 o'clock in the defeat of the amalgamated council of strikers and unionism. At a conference between the committee representing the unions and the merchants, together with Governor Foster, an agreement was signed that the strikers be taken back, in so far as it did not conflict with contracts already made and that their wages and hours of labor be adjusted.

The position which the strike placed upon the minds of the people. In this the unions were signally defeated, as the agreement simply provides that the merchants shall not unjustly discriminate against unemployed strikers, and allows the merchants to deal directly with the men, instead of through the unions as was demanded. The freed cars began running again at 6 o'clock this morning, and all business will be fully resumed.
