Wheat made a Struggle to Score Another Advance But Failed. IT STARTED STRONGER AND HIGHER. Corn Was Steady for a Minute or so at the Opening but Soon Weakened and Declined—Stocks and Bonds.

CHICAGO, March 13.—Wheat did its best to score another advance, but, loaded down by the heavy sales of the takers of profit on yesterday's gains, it finished weak with May 5c lower. WEDNESDAY, March 13. The receipts today were 1,300 cattle, 4,000 hogs and 250 sheep, as against 1,996 cattle, 6,477 hogs and 534 sheep on Wednesday of last week. The total receipts for the week thus far are 8,900 cattle, 23,000 hogs and 1,800 sheep, as against 5,792 cattle, 12,944 hogs and 6,240 sheep the first half of last week. The receipts from January 1 to date show a loss of 100 head of cattle, 10,000 hogs and 1,000 sheep, as compared with the corresponding period of 1894.
