CHICAGO, May 17.—Wheat climbed above 70c today, July closing at 70 1/2c to 70 3/4c, almost 3c higher than yesterday. Crop damage reports were the main factor in the bulge. July corn led 1/4c, September also gained 1/4c and provisions finished with but little change.

There were less than half as many cattle on sale as a week ago and the meager offerings included a load or two of very good beef, but active and westerners. On account of the doubtful tone to reports from the east there was no inquiry to amount to anything for shipping or speculative account and the market was practically left to the dressed beef men.
