Frost Damage Feared and General Buying Fever Sent Prices Skyward. ALL THE MARKETS BROKE LATER.

Corn was as Much Torn Up and Nervous as Wheat—Traders Concluded Late in the Day that Crops Were in Good Shape.

CHICAGO, May 20.—The frost damage scare and general buying fever sent grain prices skyward today, but after sensational advances the markets all broke moderately, closing about level with yesterday.

The closing slump in wheat was accelerated by a sale of 50,000 bu. of May wheat, which had to be offered down to 75c under the July prices before a buyer was found for it.

On the Produce exchange today the butter market was firm, creamery, 10c; dairy, 7c. Eggs firm, 15c. Coffee market, 10c.
