

REPORT OF POOR HARVEST RESULTS STRENGTHEN THE MARKET.

There was little business in wheat... Easy tone prevalent at the start... Heavy arrivals in the Northwest.

CHICAGO, July 7.—Reports of rust in wheat fields and poor harvest results combined to make a stronger wheat market today.

It was not until much trade, the market being dull and dormant most of the day, with fluctuations slow and limited to 50c to 55c.

Noticed and local operators were notified to trade to any extent and the market in consequence was without any special feature.

The easy tone at the start was attributed, in a measure, to continued heavy arrivals in the Northwest.

There were liberal receipts at this point and good grading of same, both of which had a tendency to induce some selling at the opening.

The market was not very active until the middle of the day, when a fair amount of business was done.

From winter wheat regions they are sending in confirmation of previous damage reports.

Statistically the situation also favored better prices. With the single exception of continued heavy arrivals in the Northwest.

Domestic wheat all strong, but sales were without special interest in country districts in the Northwest were reduced.

Foreign wheat deliveries were not very large, the largest, it is said, ever known.

In view of such statistics shorts were good buyers and there was a general upward movement, which kept the price firm and finally sent it to 55c.

It is thought corn averaged strong all during the session there was no life to trading.

Wheat advanced, September opened a whole lot from 55c to 57c, and gradually rose to 58c.

Outs were flat. There was a fair cash advance in wheat, helped by a fair advance in flour.

Provisions were quiet, but there was a fair amount of business done in the session, and the early advance was lost.

September closed at 58c, September 1st at 57c, and September 2nd at 56c.

Estimates for Wednesday—Wheat, 50c; corn, 50c; oats, 45c; beans, 45c.

The leading futures ranged as follows: Wheat, No. 2, 57 1/2; No. 2 white, 57 1/2; No. 2 red, 57 1/2.
