MISSOURI RIVER FIVE MILES WIDE

Big Muddy Spreads Out Over the Lowlands Near Hamburg, Ia. NEBRASKA CITY, April 14.—(Special Telegram.)—The Missouri river is six inches here today, and the water is now gradually creeping over the bottom of the Iowa side, several thousand acres being already inundated.

The river is now four to five miles wide at Hamburg, Ia., and the water is rising three blocks of the Burlington depot at that place. The water here is only a few inches below the high mark of 1855.

When so much property was destroyed by the inundation of the Iowa bottom. Grave apprehensions are felt for the safety of the approach to the Burlington bridge on the east side. Every precaution is being taken to protect it.

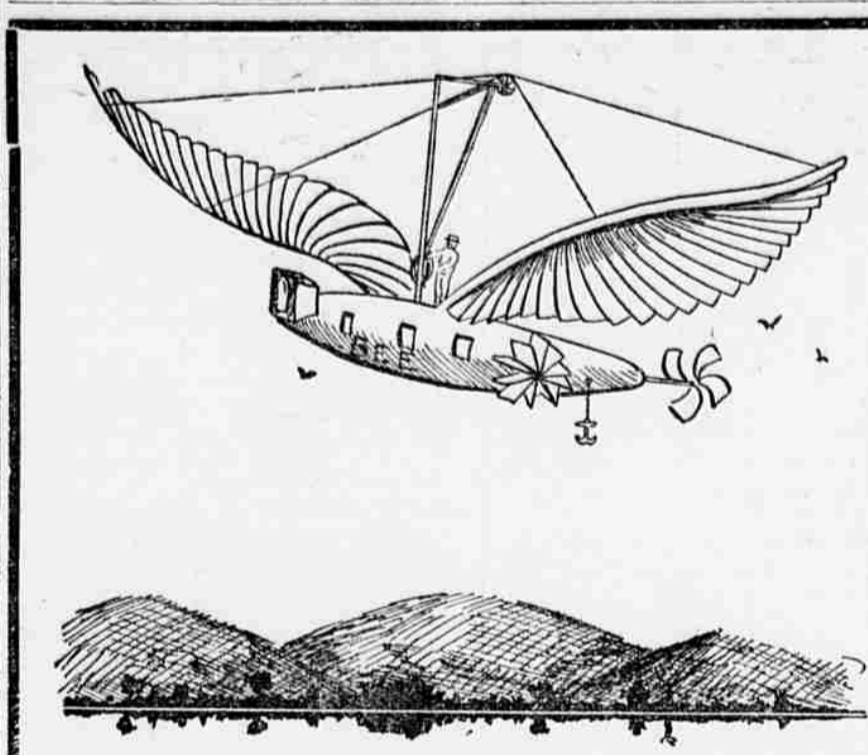
