Wheat Continues on Its Upward Course, Rising Nearly Two Cents. STRENGTH ABROAD AND CHINA BUYS

Advance at Liverpool is Aided by Crop Damage Reports from Missouri and Kansas—Other Markets Show Little Change.

CHICAGO, May 6.—Wheat today continued on the upward course it commenced yesterday and closed with a gain of 1/8c per bushel.

In wheat considerable hesitation was shown at the opening, due to the splendid weather and rather heavy receipts in the northwest, with reported practical completion of seeding in that section.

When the market opened, the price of wheat was 1 1/2c above the price of the previous day's closing figures.

It sold very sparingly at 6 1/2c, and then took an upward course, which it pursued till about 12 o'clock, when it advanced 1/8c.

The Liverpool market opened at 1 1/2c higher and in the course of the day it advanced to 1 3/4c above the previous day's closing figures.
