Wheat Makes a Break at the Start, but it Closes Firm.

LATE STRENGTH IS DUE TO FREE BUYING

July is Unchanged and September is Higher, with Corn and Pork Also Better, Ribs Lower, Oats and Lard Unchanged.

CHICAGO, June 2.—After a sensational break of 4¢ at the start today wheat closed firm, due to free buying by shorts on soft grain, and to a general quiet; September 4¢ higher; Corn was 3¢ better, and oats unchanged. Pork is 3¢ higher, ribs 6¢ lower and lard unchanged.

Everything in the way of news in wheat seemed bearish today at the start and the sentiment was in full accord with the news. Liverpool cables showed 9¢ decline for July and 2¢d in September. In addition there was a report from New York that foreigners were selling at the seaboard, the continued promise of a big wheat yield and indications of an early harvest in the south and southwest. All this created a pessimistic resulting in active liquidation, with sales of short positions which led to partial demoralization.
