JULY AND SEPTEMBER BOTH CLOSE LOWER

Other Markets Are Also Weakened in Sympathy and Corn, Oats and All Lines of Provisions Show Declines.

CHICAGO, July 5.—Bright harvest weather depressed wheat today, July closed with a loss of 3-16 and September decreased 2 1/2 cts. Corn left off 3-16 and oats 1-16. Pork lost 6c, lard 1c and the pigmeat.

Wheat started weak and remained in that condition until the end of the session. Improved crop reports and fine weather were harrowing in progress, bringing out a large line by people who bought in shorts last week and were anxious to get out again.
