Higher Cables and Small Receipts Starts Wheat Half Cent Higher.

QUICK DECLINE FOLLOWS IN MARKET

Corn Gains One-Eighth of a Cent, While Pork, Lard and Ribs Go Lower at Close.

CHICAGO, Aug. 8.—Realizing sales on expected increase in the crop movement gave wheat a setback today. September closed 14¢ lower than December 19, and declined 12¢, lard 7¢c and ribs 7¢c.

Higher Liverpool cables and small receipts started September wheat 7¢c above the price it closed Saturday. Sellers at the advance were so numerous, however, that the buying orders in the market at that time were immediately filled. Offerings still continued in such heavy volume after the market had closed that it was difficult to dispose of their holdings at any such prices.

The reasons for continued weakness were heavy estimated receipts for tomorrow and some crop reports of a bearish character.

There was even more urgent than at any time during the previous week a advancing market.

As high as it premium for September price was paid for corn, but sellers of course more could have been disposed of at the same premium but for holdovers advancing the price.
