CORN IS HIGHER WITH MANY DELIVERIES

Reports of Settlements Among Shorts and Buyers of Cash Wheat by Chicago Elevators the Chief Influences.

CHICAGO, Sept. 14.—Heavy primary receipts and indications everywhere of a rush of wheat this week took the life out of wheat bulls today and depressed prices about 1/2c. The impression prevailed that there had been private settlements of all important September contracts. September corn was firm and closed 1/2c higher, but later deliveries were heavy. Oats closed unchanged and provisions unchanged to 1/4c lower.
