There was practically no buying demand and very little importance perceptible and prices lost ground pretty steadily all day, even on the light volume of trading. Late in the afternoon Third Avenue made a sudden advance of 4 points and caused some uneasiness among the room shorts, who bought moderately to cover. But the rally was ineffectual outside of Metropolitan, Brooklyn, Transit, Sugar and Tobacco. A solid upward movement in Third Avenue was unexplained, except by last week's move in the market.

TAKES CHARGE OF THE PLAGUE

Dr. Kinyoun, Quarantine Officer at San Francisco, Will Attempt to Suppress Disease.

SAN FRANCISCO, May 21.—The federal authorities at Washington have increased Dr. Kinyoun, quarantine officer at this port, to take charge of measures to suppress the bubonic plague, which the local Board of Health has declared exists here. What action Dr. Kinyoun will take has not yet been announced.

The action of the Washington officials is thought to be due not to the seriousness of the situation, but to the inability of the San Francisco authorities to compel the Chinese and Japanese to take precautionary measures against the spread of the plague if it still exists here.
