Corn Starts Off with a Rush and Price Comes Down.

WHEAT WEAK UNDER BEAR INFLUENCE

Grain Market Dull and the Range of Prices Narrow—Port Declines Under Liquidation by Outside Holders.

CHICAGO, April 8.—The grain market resumed their normal appearance today, ruling fairly active and firm. May wheat closed 1¢/4 up and May corn 1¢/4 up higher. May oats a shade lower and provisions from 2¢/4 lower for ribs to 3¢/4 lower for pork.

For a moment at the opening the corn market resembled to a degree the wildness which characterized the market last week. Reasonable weather and liberal receipts caused a rush to sell at the start and May ranged to 16¢/4¢/4¢ up to 16¢/4 down. The rest of the general list were without notable change. Iron was quoted at 8¢/4 up, plus 1¢/4 down; western country, 14¢/4 up 15¢/4 down; and soft southern, 12¢/4 up 13¢/4 down. Oats for feeding, 14¢/4 up 15¢/4 down. Barley, 8¢/4 up 9¢/4 down. Lard, unchanged at 14¢/4¢/4¢; lard oil, quiet at 36¢/4¢/4¢.
