Sharp Reaction Toward Higher Level Occurs in Grain Market.

Wheat Helped by Reports of Damage

Lower Cables and Good Receipts Make Corn Weak at Opening—Open Easy and Provisions—Rate Dull.

CHICAGO, May 13.—A sharp reaction toward a better level occurred in the grain market today, the wheat market being helped by reports of damage to crops.

Weakness at the opening in wheat, which was higher to 70c for July delivery, was caused by heavy receipts of spot goods.

Receipts of wheat from the west were 1,415,000 bushels, against an estimate of 1,200,000 bushels.

Exporters reported 22 loads taken, seaboard clearances in wheat, 10,000 bushels, against 12,000 bushels.

Local receipts of wheat, 1,415,000 bushels, against an estimate of 1,200,000 bushels.

Provisions were dull, ruling easy for the most part and closing firm in sympathy with grain and stock markets.

On the Produce exchange today the butter market was steady, receipts of wheat, dairies 119,616 cwt.
