GOVERNMENT CROP REPORT

Average of Corn Planted is Less Than a Year Ago.

CONDITION IS BEST IN NEBRASKA. WASHINGTON, July 10.—Preliminary returns to the statistician of the Department of Agriculture on the average of corn planted indicate a reduction of 400,000 acres, or 5 per cent, from the area planted last year.

Winter and Spring Wheat Are Both Improved—Oats Show Shrinkage—Barley at Its Best—Rye Excellent—Sweet Potatoes Poor.

Spring Wheat. The condition of winter wheat improved during June, being 83.3 on July 1, as compared with 87.8 on June 1, 80.8 on July 1, 1900, 65.9 at the corresponding date in 1899 and a ten-year average of 80.2.

Oats. The average condition of the oat crop is 83.7, as compared with 85.3 one month ago, 82.5 on July 1, 1900, 90.0 at the corresponding date in 1899 and a ten-year average of 87.7.

Barley. The average condition of barley is 91.1 as against 91.0 one month ago, 76.3 on July 1, 1900, 92.0 at the corresponding date in 1899 and a ten-year average of 87.1.

WINTER RYE.

The average condition of winter rye is 93.6, as compared with 99.6 on July 1, 1900, 83.3 at the corresponding date in 1899 and a ten-year average of 89.2.
