QUANT PALACE AT SANTA FE

Most Interesting Historic Structure in the United States.

TERRITORIAL SEAT OF AUTHORITY

A Relic of Yagor Days and People Adapted to Modern Needs—Its Histo of Age and Associations.

TERRITORIAL SEAT OF AUTHORITY

One of the least known yet most interesting historic structures in the United States is the governor's palace at Santa Fe.

This old palace is a long one-story building, bounding the side of the beautiful plaza which occupies the center of Santa Fe.

In the year 1680 the native Pueblo Indians of New Mexico rose against the Spaniards and drove them from the country.

At this house in 1807 Lieutenant Pike was brought before Governor Alencaster on an invasion of the Spanish archives in 1822 the Mexican standard, with its eagle and cactus, was raised in token that New Mexico was no longer a dependency of Spain.

Mr. Otero, the present governor of New Mexico, prefers to occupy his own residence, which is near by. So the palace, during the last year, has been the home of Mr. and Mrs. George P. Wallace, Mr. Wallace, resident of Canton, O., was appointed secretary of the territory by his old friend, President McKinley.
