Advent of Hinkle to County Jail Marks an Epoch and Now Even Jim Callahan is Overshadowed

Charles T. Hinkle, the ambidextrous colored man who, in the midst of a busy and picturesque career of burglary, found time to serve as vestryman and pillar in the Church of the Deacon, was an active participant in the regular weekly religious service at the county jail yesterday afternoon.

After having been the star prisoner in the police station for several days, Hinkle was transferred to the county jail Saturday afternoon—just in time for the Sunday service.

The advent of Hinkle marked an epoch in the county jail. Even Jim Callahan, who is still in confinement after having once been acquitted of the Cudahy kidnaping, is overshadowed by this man Hinkle—the of the worshipful voice and prying "himmy" immediately after Hinkle was thrust behind the county bars it was evident that his notoriety had preceded him and there was a general craning of necks.

"Don't let him in here, Tom!" shouted one of the prisoners to Jailor Flynn. "He'll be wanting to take up a collection." "Is that Deacon Hinkle?" asked another. "Hump, I don't see no medals on him!"

But for the most part the prisoners were respectful in their reception of the back-sliding vestryman and stared at him as they would have stared at any distinguished person.

Hinkle shares a cell with four other colored men, all somewhat noted in their respective lines, but inglorious as compared with him. There is William O'Neill, who is serving six months for burglary, but so far as known he never committed but the one offense in his life, and was caught at that, so he has but an inferior claim to distinction.

Finally, there is Charles Burke, who is entirely outclassed, being charged with cutting with intent to kill. He hasn't had his trial yet.

It is with such company as this that Vestryman Hinkle will spend his time until the district court is ready to hear one or more of the cases against him.
