CREWS RESCUED BY LIFE SAVING SERVICE

FORT HURON, Mich., Sept. 8.—After one of the roughest nights ever known on Lake Huron, made worse by a heavy pall of smoke that overhung the water, six vessels are wrecked on the beach, three miles north of here.
