Universal Selling Places the Market in the Hands of the Bears.

PRICES OF GRAIN ARE PRESSED DOWN. Country Support is Lacking and Commission Houses Deluge the Pit with Orders—Lacks the Only Bull Incentive.

CHICAGO, Dec. 11.—Universal selling in grain today placed the control of markets in the hands of the bears and practically exterminated the long camp that has terrorized shorts for the last week.

Liquidation and short selling enough to press prices down two ticks the day before yesterday, aggregated too much and everything, including the wheat market, may want closed lower. Provisions closed to a fair extent from yesterday.

Provisions were liberal and prices were generally steady. Choice mixed hogs brought largely from \$6.15 to \$6.20, the highest price since Dec. 1, 1901.

Receipts of hogs were liberal again today, but the demand for the heavy weights was not so great as yesterday. The market opened fairly active on the strength of the heavy weights, but from strong to 30 or 35 lbs. heavier, the bulk sold from \$5.75 to \$6.00.

On the other hand, the lighter weights and bids were generally weak to lower and in some cases, the market was a little more active on the strength of the heavy weights.
