Find of Interesting Old Letters in a Eumage Pile in Washington.

Letters from Conkling, Greeley, Sumner and Montgomery Blair Concerning Appointments in the Departments.

Not the least interesting incident in connection with the present investigation into Postoffice department scandals, says a New York Sun letter, was the recent discovery in an old out of the way file case of a number of autograph letters of recommendation written by men famous in American history.

Postmaster General Payne recently requested the appointment clerk of the department to find a misplaced document which was desired for reference in a matter growing out of the general inquiry now in progress.

The file case had apparently been considered of no value for it had been stored away in one of the department's coal bins and eventually would have been broken up and its contents burned.

The papers include letters of recommendation from Horace Conkling, written in 1866 when he was a representative from New York; Horace Greeley, Charles Sumner and others.
