Possibility of War Between Russia and Japan is Paramount in Wheat. WET WEATHER ADVANCES CORN PRICES. Oats Market Strong with Other Grains.

CHICAGO, Dec. 19.—The possibility of war between Russia and Japan was paramount today in affecting prices of wheat. On an active general demand May closed with a gain of 1/4c.

Trading in wheat was on a very large scale and the market showed greater activity than for a long while. Local holders appeared to have almost no wheat in the situation.

Corn prices advanced on the strength in wheat and because of the wet weather prevailing since the middle of the week. The extremely liberal export business of the past two days and the continued small receipts caused a good demand at the start.
