Decreased World's Available Supply of Wheat Strengthens Prices

REDUCED SUPPLY ALSO IMPROVES MARKET

May Corn and Oats Both Higher, but Provisions Are Unchanged and in Several Lines Lower for the Day.

CHICAGO. Feb. 1.—A decrease in the world's available supply of wheat strengthened to wheat prices today. Prospects of a reduction in primary receipts also contributed to the better tone seen. The May option cashed at 34c. per bushel, up 1c. per bushel up to 3c. while May oats were 1c. higher. Provisions were unchanged to be lower.

Before the opening hour for improvements in the market were made known, a deluge of news of bearish character Foreign grain markets were lower, world's shipments for the week extremely liberal, and the quantity of wheat offered to the market was increased.
