Iowa Crop Bulletin. The climatic and crop survey bulletin for the week ending May 7 has just been issued. It is as follows: "The last week was very favorable for farm work and normal growth of vegetation. There was an average excess of 3 to 5 degrees in the daily mean temperature, and generally sufficient rainfall to moisten the surface and quicken growth of grain and grass. Except in a few localities the rainfall has not been sufficient to materially delay field work. At the close of the week the temperature fell very near to the frost line in northern districts, but there are no reports of damage."
