INCREASES IN THE VALUATIONS. Counties Already Reported Show Net Gain of Sixty-Four Per Cent.

LINCOLN, July 3.—(Special.)—If the reports to the State Board of Equalization from ten counties in the state of the assessed valuation of the property in each is an indication of what the other counties intend to return, the assessed valuation of Nebraska property this year will be in the neighborhood of 64 per cent higher than it was last year.

THE total assessment of all property in the state last year in round numbers was \$18,000,000 and based on the increase shown in the returns made by the ten counties mentioned, the assessment this year will amount to \$24,375,000, making the actual value of all property in the state \$24,375,000.
