

**Evening Classes in Philosophy and Oratory in the Creighton College of Law 1904-1905.**

As stated in the announcement of the Creighton College of Law for 1904-1905, the law school faculty will be assisted by members of the university faculty who will give systematic instruction in rational philosophy and oratory.

These classes, whilst primarily undertaken to afford special help to matriculants in the law school, will be open to others who may desire to follow the subjects discussed.

The classes will meet in the Creighton Medical college, corner Fourteenth and Davenport streets, every Monday and Friday evening at 8 o'clock, beginning November 7.

The program of studies for the season will include logic, by C. Coppens, S. J.; oratory, M. J. Ryan, S. J.; ethics, M. J. Stritch, S. J.; and psychology and theology, M. J. Connor, S. J.

A moderate fee for the course will be required of all who attend, except the regular matriculants of the schools of law and medicine.

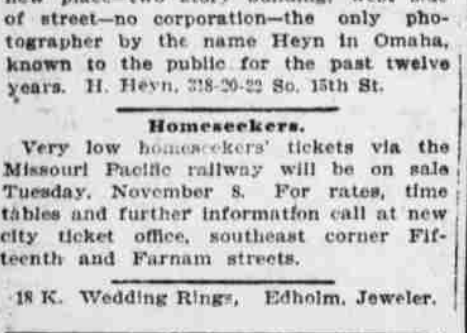
