

GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET

Winter Wheat Condition Maintained Means Largest Crop Ever.

GOVERNMENT REPORT IS VERY BEARISH

University Expert Finds Hessian Fly Well Developed in All South Platte Counties—General Condition High.

OMAHA, April 11, 1905.

The government report issued Monday afternoon gives the condition of winter wheat as compared with a condition of 74.5 in 1904, 71.2 in 1903, and 91.7 in 1902. The acreage is given at 31,200,000 acres, compared with 28,600,000 in 1904, 25,000,000 in 1903, and 22,500,000 in 1902.

The report is more bearish than had been expected, but it affects only the July wheat.

Prof. H. H. Henshaw, of the University has announced that examinations made by him show the Hessian fly well developed in all south Platte counties.
