

Two Large Concerns Do an Exclusive Manufacturing Business_Three Large Wholesale Houses.

Reaching farther into the west for their trade than almost any other group of lesalers and manufacturers, the local frug jobbing men and pharmaceutical manufacturers, although both industries are comparatively new to Omaha, are establishing themselves more and more firmly very year and if the present rate of in rease continues will soon prove formidable rivals for the Detroit and St. Louis concerns which are the country's largest. The territory which belongs almost exclusively to Omaha's drug manufacturers and jobbers comprises Nebraska, South Dakota, Kansas and western Iowa, but these firms, especially the wholesalers, are constantly booking orders from the western coast states and the amount of trade which they secure yearly from what was primarily the territory of the drug men of other citles, is enormous. There are two pharmaceutical manufacturing house in the local field-the Henry R. Gering company and the Goodrich Drug ompany. These firms each manufacture all the standard drug preparations which they sell to wholesalers, a large part of their products going to local dealers. These men, although they do not claim for their firms that they are the largest in the section, are yet most optimistic with regard to the future. Indeed, they feel that with the amount of support which they deserve from local retailers and physicians. the possibilities of Omaha as a drug manufacturing center are almost boundless. And the way in which their business has increased by leaps and bounds seems to bear out their statements in every detail, Al-
