PREHISTORIC RELICS FOUND

Bits of Wood from Ante-Glacial Days at Learned's Place.

BURIED DEEP UNDER THE SOIL

At Two Hundred Feet Below Surface Well Diggers Come Upon Rare Find—Indian Stone Implements Abound.

Three pieces of wood that seem to have been left many feet under ground by some glacial movement, have been unearthed at the country home of Myron L. Learned, about a mile north of Florence. Mr. Learned had a 45-foot well on his place and it went dry. He found it impossible to bore it deeper and set men to work digging. At the depth of a little more than 200 feet, which was reached last week, the diggers brought up the three pieces of wood excellently preserved. The depth makes it certain that they must have been brought there years ago. They were just about at the level of the river and nearby was found some petrified wood, which had evidently been under great pressure.

The wood was agreed upon between the rings of growth, indicating that it had been swollen in water and the rings were thicker than they are in ordinary Nebraska trees. Mr. Learned was unable to determine what species the trees belong to and sent the pieces to Robert F. Gillet, of Prof. Bessey of the State University, who will try to identify them with some period of time, modern or ancient.

FRIENDS BOOM JUDGE HOLCOMB

Talk of Running Him for the Position of Supreme Justice of the State.

A boom has been started among influential democratic politicians to make Judge S. R. Holcomb of Broken Bow the next supreme justice of the state. Judge Holcomb has been governor of the state and has served on the supreme bench and is still practicing his profession at his home. Of recent years Judge Holcomb has been less active because of illness which left him partially paralyzed, but that does not keep him from being busy. His record as governor and judge warrant his candidacy in the opinion of the democrats, and one

prominent member of that party in Omaha Monday declared that the boom is becoming rapidly widespread. No promise has been obtained from the ex-governor to indicate that he would care to run for the bench again, but he will be prevailed upon to do so if possible.

Spinal Meningitis Takes Another Victim

Dread Disease Causes Death of Mary Minor—Second Sudden Death in House.

Death visited the house at 233 California street Sunday evening for the second time within a week when Mary Minor, a little five-year-old girl, died of spinal meningitis at the Swedish Mission hospital. The little girl was taken ill some days ago just about the same time as Miss Anna Sties who died from the effects of pneumonia poisoning after having eaten some candy purchased at a ten cent store. Mary Minor, who died yesterday, is not known to have partaken of any of the candy but her sickness and death almost at the same time and in the same house is considered a peculiar coincidence. The Minor family has but lately come to Omaha from Baltimore.
