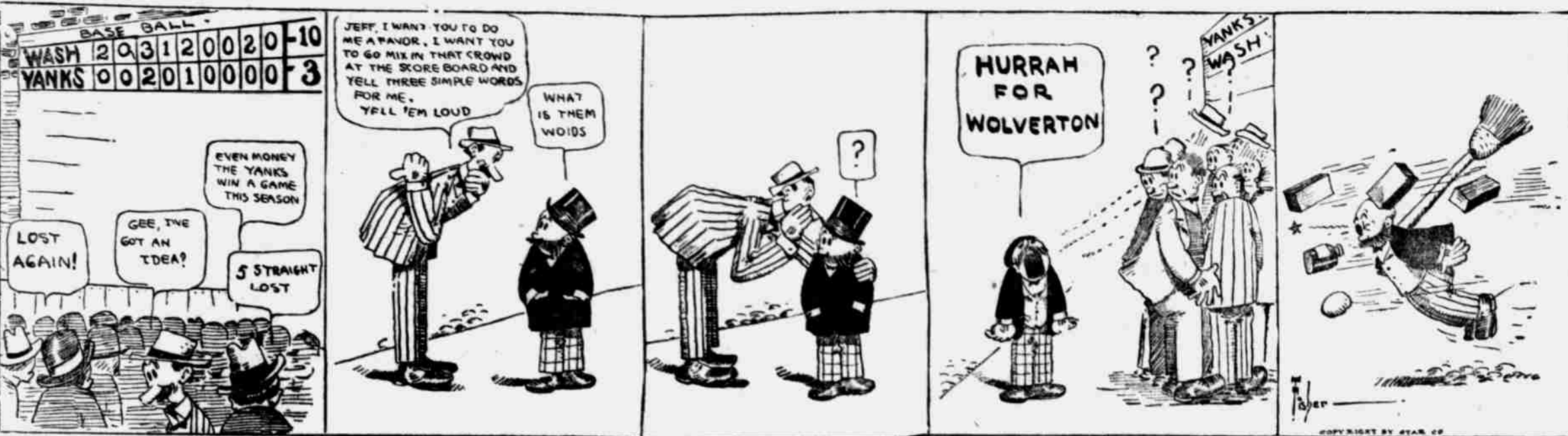

Tuttle Drinks Acid to Cast Off Weight of Advancing Years
Temporarily insane while in poor health and fearing that he was growing too old to be useful, John M. Tuttle drank the contents of a bottle of carbolic acid on Tuesday afternoon about 1:30 o'clock in his home at 912 North Twenty-eighth avenue. This verdict was reached yesterday afternoon by the jury which investigated Tuttle's death. He was a pioneer of Omaha and known to thousands as "the mayor of Sneeley." It was brought out that Tuttle had been dependent for some time. Just where he procured the poison was not learned. Dr. McLaughlin told of how the poison burned the throat, mouth, neck and stomach. The funeral will probably be held Sunday afternoon, though the arrangements for the services have not been completed.

Runaway Horse Hits Man on Car
While reading an account of the Titanic disaster on the rear platform of a south-bound car at Sixteenth and Chicago streets early last night Michael McCulligan, a bartender, living at 625 South Seventeenth street, was seriously injured when a runaway horse dashed across Chicago street and up on the platform. McCulligan was knocked half way through a window and his face and shoulders badly cut. Both of the horse's eyes were cut out and its skull crushed when it struck the iron work on the car. McCulligan was rushed to police headquarters, where Police Surgeon Ash restored him to consciousness and attended his injuries. Later he was taken to his home in an ambulance. The horse was hitched to a grocery delivery wagon and became frightened when a newsboy ran directly under its head. The wagon was wrecked and the animal will have to be killed.
