Business Men to Hear of the Keokuk Water Power Plant

Dexter P. Cooper, superintendent of the Illinois division of construction for the Mississippi River Power company, which is building the largest water power plant in the world at Keokuk, Ia., and Hamilton, Ill., will deliver a lecture before the public affairs committee of the Commercial club Friday noon.

He will talk on the evolution of water power and its relation to industrialism and commercialism. The lecture will be illustrated by stereopticon views showing the history of water power development; with a series of pictures showing how the water power plant and big dam is being built in the Mississippi river.

The construction of this dam and plant is said to be an engineering and economic achievement equalled only by the Panama canal.

Mr. Cooper is a younger brother of Hugh L. Cooper, the engineer who is building the great dam and hydraulic installation at Keokuk.

Production of Milk in Nebraska Great

Nebraska cows are producing about 15 carloads of cream daily and a greater portion of it is finding its way to the Omaha market, where it is manufactured into butter. The railroads have found the handling of cream a considerable source of revenue and this season cream cars comprise a portion of the equipment of all the passenger and express trains.

The Burlington daily has about fifty cream cars in the service; the Union Pacific, about thirty; the Northwestern and Omaha roads, about twenty; the Rock Island and Missouri Pacific, about twelve each.

Roads figure that the amount of cream handled in Nebraska so far this summer is at least 10 per cent greater than ever before.

The Omaha creameries draw from about 25 miles to the west, but from there on the bulk of the cream goes to Denver.

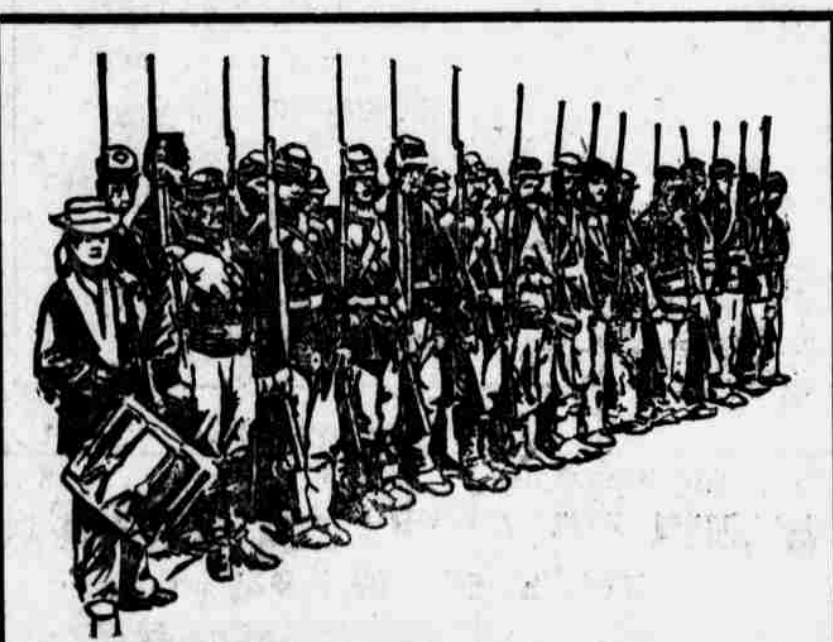
