

FIELD CAMPAIGN IS ORDERED

United States Army and Guards Will Maneuver in West.

GENERAL SMITH TO COMMAND

Realistic Scenes Will Be Enacted in Wyoming When Imaginary Enemies Are Drawn Up Against Each Other.

The Western Division of the United States army is planning for maneuver campaigns jointly with the state militia.

Pole mountain, twenty miles west of Fort D. A. Russell, Wyo., near the highest point on the Union Pacific railroad.

This is part of a plan of maneuvers this summer referred to and approved by General Smith.

Included in the arrangements the regular troops of Fort Russell, comprising several regiments, will participate.

The militia will complete field practice on July 17, if the prepared schedule is maintained.

General Smith is also instructed to take command of the joint troops of Forts Mackenzie, Robinson and Meade after the training of militia at Pole mountain.

The time allotted to the maneuvers of the regular troops at the crossing will be limited to a week or ten days.
