#### TO INSPECT X-RAY MACHINES

Committee of Electricians and Physicians to Look Over Devices.

SOME ARE REAL FIRE MENACE

Hospitals and Physicians' Offices to Be Visited to Look Over the Alleged Fire Hazard Ap-

paratus.

X-ray machines and all electro-theraneutic devices used in the medical profession in Omaha will be inspected by a committee from the electrical organization and the medical society to determine to what degree they constitute a fire

City Electrician Michaelsen has condemned three new X-ray machines as unsafe and vibrators and electrifiers are being inspected.

Physicians will be required to have these devices installed under the direction of the city electrical inspection department, which they have not been doing

Several hospitals and physicians' offices will be forced to either abandon machines now in use or throw sufficient safeguards about them to satisfy the ordinance.

Mr. Michaelsen has taken the matter up with the manufacturers of X-ray machines and charged them with "not keeping step with the electrical profesdon," in that they build unsafe machines. "Many of these machines, we have found, constitute a great fire hazard," said Michaelsen, "and we have taken steps to have the 100 or more X-ray machines and other electrical apparatus ised in the hospitals inspected.

"We do not want to work a hardship on physicians and so will have a joint committee of electricians and physicians

Some of these expensive X-rays draw s much as seventy-five amperes, which is equivalent to 300 small incandescents. There are other machines, like the Finsen ray, used to cure disease by light rays, that use a great amount of elec-

Mr. Michaelsen says that from an electrical standpoint many of the most expensive electrical devices are not properly constructed. Omaha physicians are well supplied with these machines, which are being constantly elaborated.
